1	Route	<p>Route if Police in attendance will be: Town Hall, Broad Street, The Cross, Church Street and Church Bank. (in reverse on the return) Marshalling up in Park Lane (outward) and outside the Inglenook Café (return)</p> <p>Route if the Police are not in attendance will be: Town Hall, Park Lane, High Street, Jehu Road, Brook Street, Union Street and Church Bank. (outward) Marshalling up in Park Lane. Inglenook Café (marshalling up), Church Street, Broad Street and Town Hall. (return)</p>	Decision taken on the day by the Town Clerk on route to be taken in line with details to the left.	LOW
2	Marshals	Marshalls shall be present in high viz jackets at all junctions where traffic can enter the route and also a marshal at the rear of the procession.	All marshals to meet with the Town Clerk prior to going to their positions on the route.	LOW
3	Chief Marshall	There will a specific person allocated the job of parade marshal who shall order and lead the procession.	Appointment to be made by the Town Clerk prior to the event.	LOW
4	Parade movements	When the parade moves off it remains as a single unit, at traffic lights if the lights are at red when the front of the procession arrives it will stop, otherwise the procession will continue once it has passed the green light in a single unit.	Instructions to be given to Chief Marshal to ensure procedure is followed.	LOW
5	Police	The Police shall be informed of any processions taking place.	Police informed.	LOW
6	First Aid	First Aid trained personnel shall be in attendance.	Staff to be arranged in advance.	LOW
