Introduction

This form sets out some basic information for those applying for grant aid from Welshpool Town Council and includes the application form.

Amount of grant aid

Grants are generally limited to £250 per application.

Who can apply for grant aid?

Any organisation (charitable, not for profit or volunteer based) who serves the Community of Welshpool Town Council (Welshpool, Belan, Pool Quay and Golfa). An individual may not apply for grant aid.

What you need to do?

Complete this form and return it with a copy of your last annual accounts or a copy of the bank statement of the organisation applying for the grant.

How soon will you know?

Grant applications received by the 3rd Wednesday in the month will be decided on the 4th Wednesday in that month at the Full Council Meeting and you will be informed of the result the following day. You are welcome to attend the Council Meeting at which the grant is being decided.

What can the organisation spend the money on?

The grants issued by Welshpool Town Council can be used for a specific project or for general running costs. Although you are asked for an idea of what the money would be used for it can be for capital or revenue purposes.
